1. Nominee Category

Please circle one depending on whether you are nominating an individual or a group.

2. Name (affiliation/position, etc)/Group Name (name of the representative)

If the nominee is an individual, please write his/her name and current affiliation/position, and if it is a group, please write the group's name and the name of the group's representative.

3. Address or Location

If the nominee is an individual, please write his/her home address or work address (indicating either home or office), and if it is a group, please write its location.

4. Phone number/FAX number/e-mail Address/Web Page Address
