

How to use my family's safety confirmation card

(Wagaya no anpi kakunin kado)

(Drawn up in Apr. 2024)

What is my family's safety confirmation card?

- When to use ? ⇒ When a large earthquake or a flood disaster happens.
- Where to use ? ⇒ At safety confirmation sites of each resident and neighborhood association (=Jichikai and Chonakai)
- How to use ? ⇒ Please fill your family information in it and submit it to a board member of your resident and neighborhood association.

When a large-scale disaster occurs, you should first ensure your personal safety. After strong shaking stops, please evacuate to a previously determined evacuation site. Then, you should go to the safety confirmation sites designated by your resident and neighborhood association once your safety has been confirmed under such a condition as a large TSUNAMI warning had been lifted. At that time, please utilize the “my family's safety confirmation card” to avoid dense and crowded situation and to conduct safety confirmation immediately.

◎In an actual disaster, the card information will be used for search operation of a missing person.
