It is broadcast radio that is useful as a measure to send information to people staying outside during an emergency. In Yaizu city, the system's speakers are installed in 200 places. But, the voice of broadcast radio is sometimes hard to hear when we stay indoors, in an unfavorable place, or in unfavorable wind direction. Please understand how to collect information diversely and routinely to get it immediately during a disaster and to secure
