## How to use my family's safety confirmation card

(Wagaya no anpi kakunin kado)

(Drawn up in Apr. 2024)

## What is my family's safety confirmation card?

- When to use  $? \Rightarrow$  When a large earthquake or a flood disaster happens.
- Where to use ? ⇒ At safety confirmation sites of each resident and neighborhood association (=Jichikai and Chonaikai)
- How to use? ⇒ Please fill your family information in it and submit it to a board member of your resident and neighborhood association.

When a large-scale disaster occurs, you should first ensure your personal safety. After strong shaking stops, please evacuate to a previously determined evacuation site. Then, you should go to the safety confirmation sites designated by your resident and neighborhood association once your safety has been confirmed under such a condition as a large TSUNAMI warning had been lifted. At that time, please utilize the "my family's safety confirmation card" to avoid dense and crowded situation and to conduct safety confirmation immediately.

OIn an actual disaster, the card information will be used for search operation of a missing person.
