## 14 First-aid Station

In the event that an Advisory Information or Warning Declaration is issued, or when disasters occur suddenly without issuance of an Advisory Information or Warning Declaration, eleven city-designated first-aid stations will be established. Patients will undergo triage and be categorized according to the severity of their wounds to determine the order of treatment.

Also, three first-aid hospitals will be open to accept and provide treatment to the wounded and severely wounded.
